ENHANCING SAFETY AND SECURITY

- Replace select exterior doors
- Upgrade exterior lighting
- Replace phone system
- Upgrade security camera system
- Replace entrance intercoms
- Upgrade access control
- Install emergency alert system
- Replace PA system
- Replace radio/walkie-talkies
- Upgrade existing secure vestibules
- Upgrade security glass on exterior windows

IMPROVING INSTRUCTIONAL SPACES AND TECHNOLOGY

- Replace casework (countertops and hardware)
- Replace flooring in classrooms, media center, office, cafeteria, music, and at thresholds
- Renovate space for emerging programs
- Upgrade power and wireless infrastructure to support technology
- Replace student, teacher, and staff computers
- Replace student personal devices
- Replace device charging and storage stations
- Replace AV devices (display, sound, PA, and document camera) in classrooms, conference room, and collaboration spaces
- Replace network switches, racks, wireless infrastructure, and cabling to support technology

IMPROVING INSTRUCTIONAL SPACES AND TECHNOLOGY (CONTINUED)

- Replace printers
- Replace select furniture
- Purchase STEM/robotics equipment

IMPROVING INFRASTRUCTURE AND SCHOOL SITES

- Replace select roofing
- Replace water heater and pump
- Replace water bottle filler
- Replace HVAC equipment and components and temperature controls
- Repave lots, and replace underground stormwater structures
- Repave driveways and sidewalks
- Upgrade site sign to digital

ENHANCING ARTS AND ATHLETICS

- Replace athletic fields, exterior courts, and furnishings
