- Upgrade power and wireless infrastructure to support technology

- Replace AV devices (display, sound, PA, and document camera) in classrooms, conference room, and collaboration spaces
- Replace printers
- Replace select furniture
- Purchase STEM/robotics equipment
- Replace network switches, racks, wireless infrastructure, and cabling to support technology

IMPROVING INFRASTRUCTURE AND SCHOOL SITES

- Replace select roofing
- Replace exterior stucco with metal panels
- Replace water heater and pump
- Replace water bottle filler
- Replace HVAC equipment and components and temperature controls
- Repave north parking lot and install underground stormwater structure
- Replace sidewalks
- Repave west and south lots
