

APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO
THE L'ANSE CREUSE PUBLIC SCHOOLS BOARD OF EDUCATION

By law the Board of Education has 30 days to appoint an individual to a Board vacancy. The appointed member's term is until December 31, 2026.

To be eligible for an appointment to the L'Anse Creuse Public Schools Board of Education, you must:

- Be a registered voter in the School District of L'Anse Creuse Public Schools
- Be at least 18 years of age

You should plan to be available to interview in person on March 19, 2025.

In order for applicants to understand the demands on a Board member's time, some of the responsibilities and events are listed below:

- Attending 2 Board meetings a month with an average prep time of 2 to 3 hours
- Attending numerous school events annually
- Attending end of year activities such as honors' nights and graduation ceremonies
- Attending, when possible, monthly MCSBA dinner meetings, and school board related community events
- Participating on MISD committees
- Complying with required Superintendent Evaluation Process

The Board of Education will consider all applications submitted by the deadline (no late applications will be accepted). Additionally, the Board reserves the right to also consider others to fill the existing vacancy on the Board.
