L'Anse Creuse Secondary Students Compete to be the 2025 LC Idol

CLINTON TWP, Mich. – The L'Anse Creuse Public Schools' Music Programs are proud to present the 2025 L'Anse Creuse (LC) Idol and Idol Junior Competition, which will take place starting at 7:00 pm on March 18, 2025 at the John Armstrong Performing Arts Center (JAPAC). Doors open at 6:30 pm and admission is \$5 cash at the door for school-aged and older.

LC Idol is an annual singing competition not unlike American Idol—L'Anse Creuse students in 6th-12th grade audition in front of a panel of judges to earn their spot, and a selection of 10 middle schoolers and 10 high schoolers are chosen to compete in the final show to earn the title of “L'Anse Creuse Idol.” Secondary students from around the district auditioned back in February, and those chosen to move onto this next round of the competition have been practicing for the past month in preparation for their performance.

Audience members play an active role in the evening, and are able to vote with their mobile device for the top three singers for each competition. The competition is broken into two acts—Act 1 is the middle school competition (Idol Jr.) and Act 2 is the high school competition (Idol). The winner of each competition will receive a trophy, a cash prize, and an engraved plaque for their home school's trophy.

This annual competition is a wonderful way for students to practice their vocal skills, participate in friendly competition, and show off their abilities to the L'Anse Creuse community. The district is proud to present this event, and looks forward to showcasing the wonderful talent of our secondary students.
