L'Anse Creuse Board Names Keith Howell as New Superintendent

CLINTON TOWNSHIP, Mich. - The Board of Education for L'Anse Creuse Public Schools approved the appointment of Keith Howell as the new superintendent.

"The Board of Education worked diligently to find the next superintendent," said Board President Adam Lipski. "Looking forward, the Board will work together with Mr. Howell to lead this great district. We are confident and optimistic in this endeavor."

Howell is currently serving as the Executive Director of PreK-12 Teaching and Learning at Grosse Pointe Public School System and was previously the Director of PreK-Elementary Curriculum and Instruction for eight years. Howell has also held elementary principal positions in both the Grosse Pointe Public School System and VanDyke Public Schools, giving him over 20 years of administrative experience.

Howell has a Masters in Educational Administration from Saginaw Valley State University; and a Bachelors of Science in Elementary Education from Oakland University.

The L'Anse Creuse Board of Education conducted a superintendent search and received 14 applications for the position. Working together, they selected four candidates for first round of interviews on August 19 and August 21. The Board then narrowed the candidate pool to two, and a second round of interviews was held on August 27 and August 28. The final step in the process was the special board meeting held September 4 to select the superintendent.
