Students Not Feeling Well/Attendance

If your student is ill, please do not send them to school. **We kindly ask for students to remain home until they are 24-hours free of fever or vomiting and their symptoms are improving.** Please contact the LCHS Attendance Office to report your child's absence at (586) 783-6400. **NOTE: all attendance will be marked accordingly within 24 business hours of when we are notified of the student's absence from class.** We appreciate your cooperation and patience.

Parking Lot Construction-PLEASE READ!

As a reminder, the **BACK PARKING LOT** (along the baseball & football fields) is still an active construction zone and is **CLOSED TO ALL TRAFFIC** until further notice. **Students/Parents should not be using the back lot for drop-off, pick-up or when arriving for after-school practices or conditioning sessions. All access to the building is to be made through the front of the school through Door #1.** Only authorized personnel are allowed in the back lot. We appreciate your cooperation.

1. Login to SchoolPay to pay for your parking permit

3. When all of the required information has been submitted, students can pick up their parking permit sticker in the Main Office with Mrs. Lazaris.

HOME Game Admission Policies

- All students (of any age) MUST have their ID to enter Athletic events.
- Children under high school age (middle school & younger) WILL NOT be permitted into events unless accompanied by an adult. The adult is expected to stay for the entire event with the student. Children under high school age will not be granted admission into any game with a high school student.
- Admission cost: \$5.00 – we accept cash and credit card (a small fee does apply to all credit card transactions).
- All students are expected to follow the guidelines outlined in the LCPS Student Code of Conduct.

AWAY Game Admission Policies

- Payment protocols vary by school. Please make sure you check the away school's website for information on how to obtain entry at their facility. Some schools require entry purchase online BEFORE the event.
- Students are REQUIRED to have their actual ID when attending an away game. Most schools WILL NOT accept a photo copy of an ID, picture of an ID, a coach or LCHS staff member vouching for the student or bringing up their profile in PowerSchool. Students that do not have an actual ID will not

be permitted entry into the game. This is per the away school's policy.

COMMUNITY SERVICE:

New Requirements-Community Service

Effective August 2025, students will be limited in the number of donation hours they may count toward the Community Service graduation requirement. Students may donate a maximum of 10 donation hours (limit of 5 hours per donation) toward the required 40 hours. The remaining hours must be completed through active participation in community, school, church, or non-profit organizations. Please note that all donation hours submitted prior to this change will remain documented and will still count toward graduation requirements. This log will be turned into Mrs. Rickel in the Community Service Office located in the Media Center.

Community Service Hours Required

All students are required to complete a minimum of 40 hours of Community Service before graduation. **These hours are a graduation requirement.** We highly recommend students complete their 40 hours BEFORE their Senior year. **Students that do not submit the minimum hours required before the end of their senior year are subject to a diploma hold and will not be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony.**

Class of 2026 Community Service Deadlines:

- **100 Hours must be turned in by FEBRUARY 27, 2026** to receive the Presidential Award
- **80 Hours must be turned in by MARCH 25, 2026** to receive Honor Cord

- **40 Hours must be turned in by APRIL 24, 2026** to receive Diploma
