### ***Community Service Hours Required***

All students are required to complete a minimum of 40 hours of Community Service before graduation. These hours are a graduation requirement. We

highly recommend students complete their 40 hours **BEFORE** their Senior year. Students that do not submit their served hours before the end of their senior year are subject to a diploma hold and will not be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony.

### ***Class of 2025 Community Service Deadlines:***

- **100 Hours must be turned in by FEBRUARY 28, 2025** to receive the Presidential Award
- **80 Hours must be turned in by MARCH 20, 2025** to receive Honor Cord
- **40 Hours must be turned in by APRIL 25, 2025** to receive Diploma
