24-25 Parking Permits

If your student drives a vehicle to school, a 24-25 Parking Permit is required. Parking Permits are \$40.00 & are processed electronically only. In order for a parking permit to be issued to your student, please complete the following. Payment and all of the required information must be submitted before a parking permit will be issued. Students that drive to school without purchasing a permit will be subject to a diploma hold their senior year.

- 1. Login to SchoolPay to pay for your parking permit
- Access the <u>24-25 Parking Permit Form</u>, completing the required areas and submitting pictures of the students driver's license and the vehicle registration of each vehicle that needs to be permitted.
- 3. When all of the required information has been submitted, students can pick up their parking permit sticker in the Main Office with Mrs. Lazaris.
