24-25 Parking Permits

If your student drives a vehicle to school, a 24-25 Parking Permit is required. Parking Permits are \$40.00 & are processed electronically only. In order for a parking permit to be issued to your student, please complete the

following. Payment and all of the required information must be submitted before a parking permit will be issued. Students that drive to school without purchasing a permit will be subject to a diploma hold their senior year.

1. Login to SchoolPay to pay for your parking permit
2. Access the [24-25 Parking Permit Form](#), completing the required areas and submitting pictures of the students driver's license and the vehicle registration of each vehicle that needs to be permitted.
3. When all of the required information has been submitted, students can pick up their parking permit sticker in the Main Office with Mrs. Lazaris.

Senior Fines/Diploma Holds
