Visitors To The Building

All visitors to LCHS **MUST** enter the building through the front doors into the Commons at all times. During school hours, visitors must present a valid driver's license or state id to enter the building beyond the Commons. Visitors will be issued a visitor's pass and must turn it back into the receptionist before exiting the building. We appreciate your cooperation.

Student Device Insurance

Another reminder! Medication Drop-Off

If your child will be taking medication during school hours that will need to be administered by LCHS staff, medication can be dropped off to our Medical Aide, Mrs. Perkins (please email her at perkiph@lc-ps.org to confirm she will be available). As a reminder, ALL medication (prescription and nonprescription) MUST be dropped off by a parent/guardian. Prescription medication MUST be in the original bottle with the student's name, prescription number, medication name and dosing information clearly stated. Over the counter medication, such as Tylenol, Motrin, Benedryl, Midol, etc. must be in a NEW, UNOPENED container labeled with the student's name. In addition, ALL medications MUST be delivered to us with a completed and signed medication permission slip form. This form is kept on file at LCHS – medication cannot be administered without this form.

25-26 Parking Permits

If your student drives a vehicle to school, a 25-26 Parking Permit is required. Parking Permits are \$40.00 & are processed electronically only. In order for a parking permit to be issued to your student, please complete the

following. Payment and all of the required information must be submitted before a parking permit will be issued.

- 1. Login to SchoolPay to pay for your parking permit
- Access the <u>25-26 Parking Permit Form</u>, completing the required areas and submitting pictures of the students driver's license and the vehicle registration of each vehicle that needs to be permitted.
- When all of the required information has been submitted, students can pick up their parking permit sticker in the Main Office with Mrs. Lazaris.

National Honor Society Invites

Sports Physicals

Physical forms can be found on the <u>LC Athletics Website</u>. A sports physical is considered valid if a parent/guardian signature appears in sections 2,3 & 4. **NOTE: Students must have a Sports Physical dated after April 15, 2025 from this point on in order to participate in sports for the School Year 25-26.**

Away Game Admission Policies

 Payment protocols vary by school. Please make sure you check the away school's website for information on how to obtain entry at their facility. Some schools require entry purchase online BEFORE the event. Students are REQUIRED to have their actual ID when attending an away game. Most schools WILL NOT accept a photo copy of an ID, picture of an ID, a coach or LCHS staff member vouching for the student or bringing up their profile in PowerSchool. Students that do not have an actual ID will not be permitted entry into the game. This is per the away school's policy.

COMMUNITY SERVICE:

New Requirements-Community Service

Effective August 2025, students will be limited in the number of donation hours they may count toward the Community Service graduation requirement. Students may donate a maximum of 10 donation hours (limit of 5 hours per donation) toward the required 40 hours. The remaining hours must be completed through active participation in community, school, church, or non-profit organizations. Please note that all donation hours submitted prior to this change will remain documented and will still count toward graduation requirements. Community Service Hours Required

All students are required to complete a minimum of 40 hours of Community Service before graduation. These hours are a graduation requirement. We highly recommend students complete their 40 hours BEFORE their Senior year. Students that do not submit their served hours before the end of their senior year are subject to a diploma hold and will not be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony.

Class of 2026 Community Service Deadlines:

- 100 Hours must be turned in by FEBRUARY 27, 2026 to receive the Presidential Award
- 80 Hours must be turned in by MARCH 25, 2026 to receive Honor Cord
- 40 Hours must be turned in by APRIL 24, 2026 to receive Diploma

Senior Dues

Name Verification For Graduation Diplomas

If your senior has not already completed their name verification, please make sure they access the Name Verification
Form. This information will be used to complete their diploma. NOTE: students must enter their name in the form exactly as it appears on their birth certificate. The diploma is a legal document and must state their legal name (PREFERRED NAMES CANNOT BE USED). The deadline to submit responses is no later than 3:00pm Friday, September 19th.

College Interest Form

Seniors who are interested in attending a college or university after graduation will be given the opportunity to meet with a college representative here at LCHS. The visit may be inperson or virtually. Please remember this visit should not replace the in-person tour.
