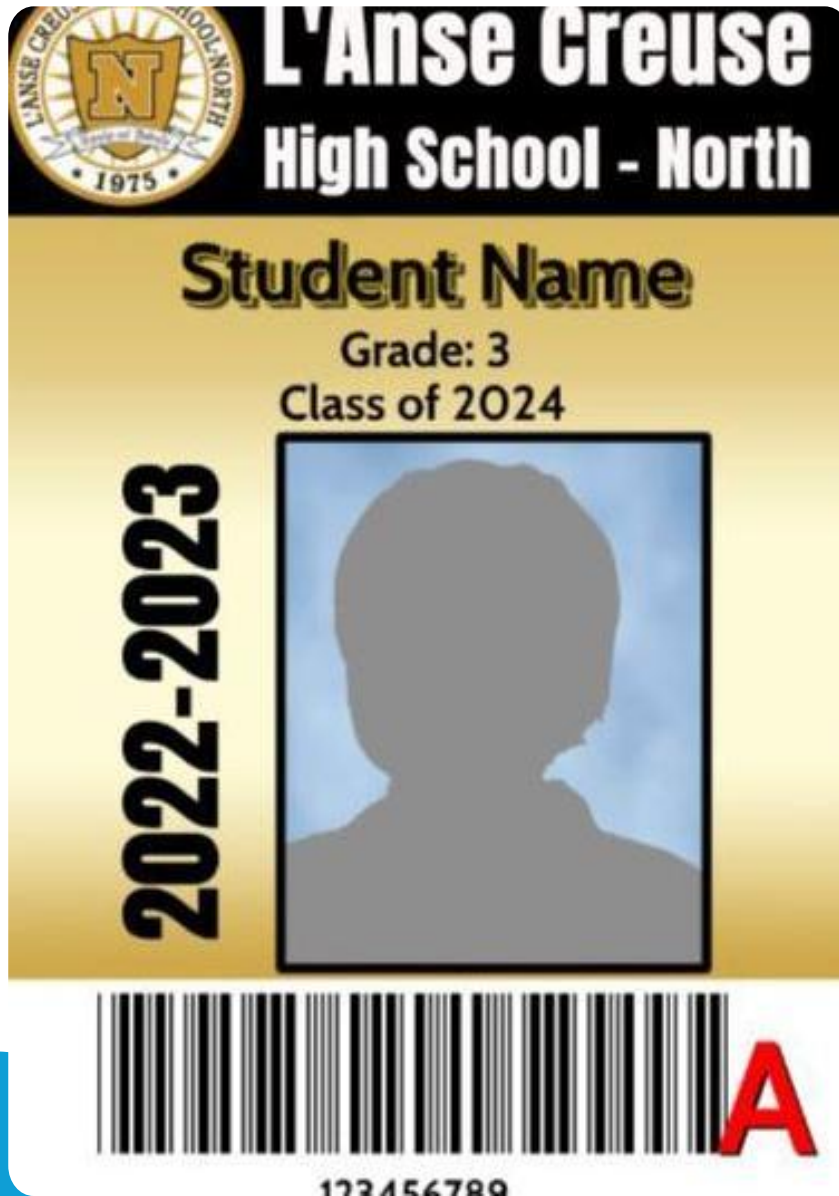

Bus Expectations

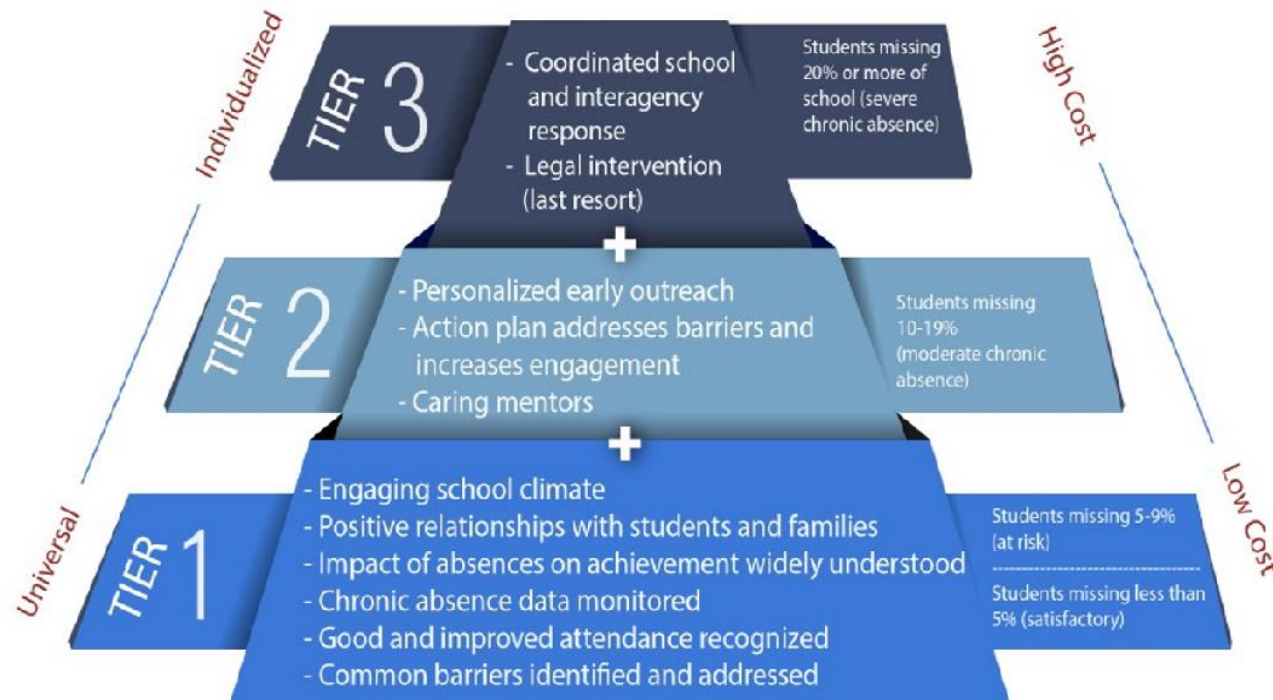
Students are expected to leave the building at the end of the school day. If students are participating in an after school activity, they should be supervised by the coach or sponsor of the activity.

Tiered System of Supports For Improving Attendance



Tier 3: >20% of school
Severe (4+ days per month)

Tier 2: >10% of school
Moderate
(2-3 days per month)

Tier 1: 5-9% of school
At Risk (1+ day per month)

Tier 1: <5% of school
Satisfactory (<1 day per month)

Attendance

- Students are allowed up to 10 absences each semester
- Turn in medical documentation to Dean's Office/Attendance clerk for medical absences
- Medical absences do not count against students
- Must call in students at LCN and Pankow
- Attendance Loss of Credit for more than 10 absences
- DTEX – over 10 minutes late

(Junior year))



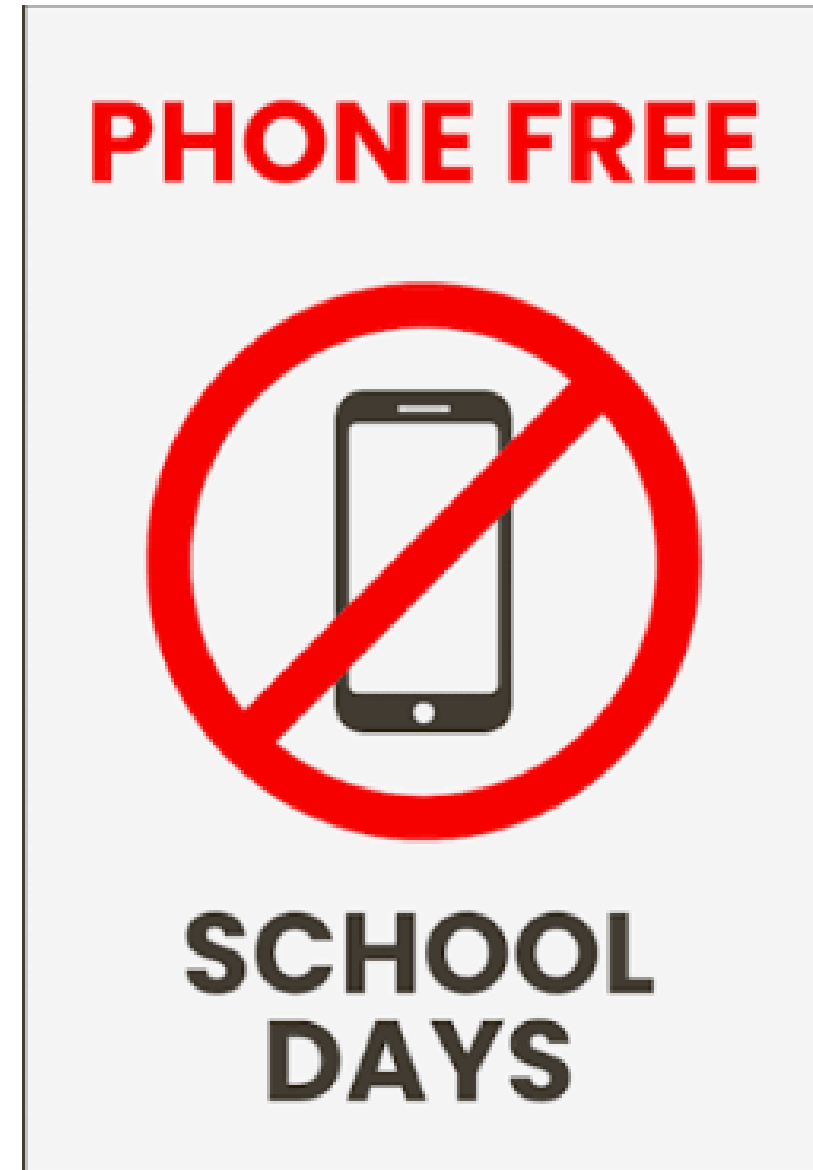
What does it mean to be "On Track" for Graduation?

- Can earn 6 credits per year
- Must have 22.5 by graduation (only a difference of 1.5 credits)
- Summer school = 1.0 credits per summer
- What is the minimum?
- End of Freshman year: 4.5 credits
- End of Sophomore year: 10.5 credits

Grading



Teacher gradebooks are set up using two categories.

One of them will reflect activities where students are required to show mastery of specific standards and learning objectives.

The other category reflects the students' completion and practice toward mastery.

PowerSchool

SCHOOLGY

- In order to access Schoology parent access, all parents/guardians will need to register for a Schoology account using the Parent Access Code received for their child. If you did not receive your Schoology Parent Access Code, please reach out to your child's teacher. While Schoology is able to be utilized in all browsers, it does tend to work most smoothly in Chrome.

To sign-up for a Schoology parent account:

Go to www.schoology.com

Click "Sign Up" at the top of the page and choose "Parent."

Enter your Parent Access Code: a 12-digit code in xxxx-xxxx-xxxx format you will receive.

Fill out the form with your information.

Click "Register" to complete.

- When you use a Parent Access Code to create an account, you are automatically associated to your child. Parent Access Codes are unique to each student, but can be used to make multiple parent accounts. You can also add additional children to your account using the "Add Child" button.

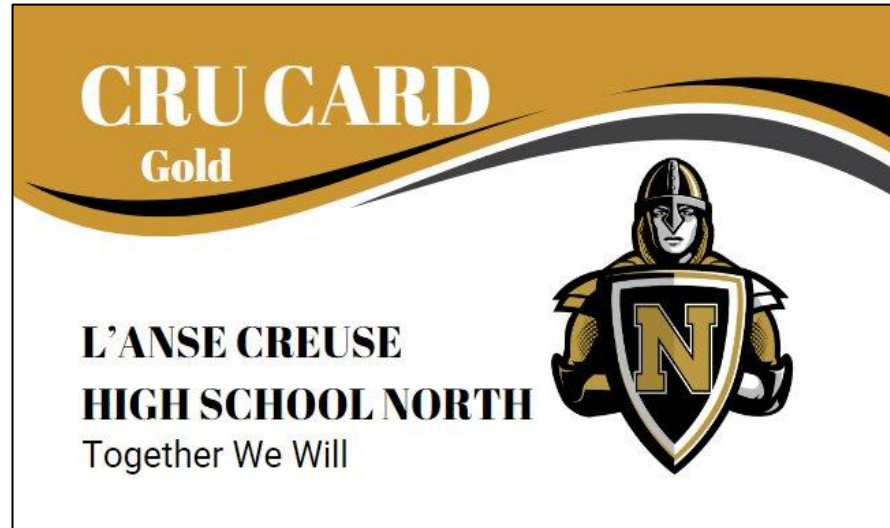

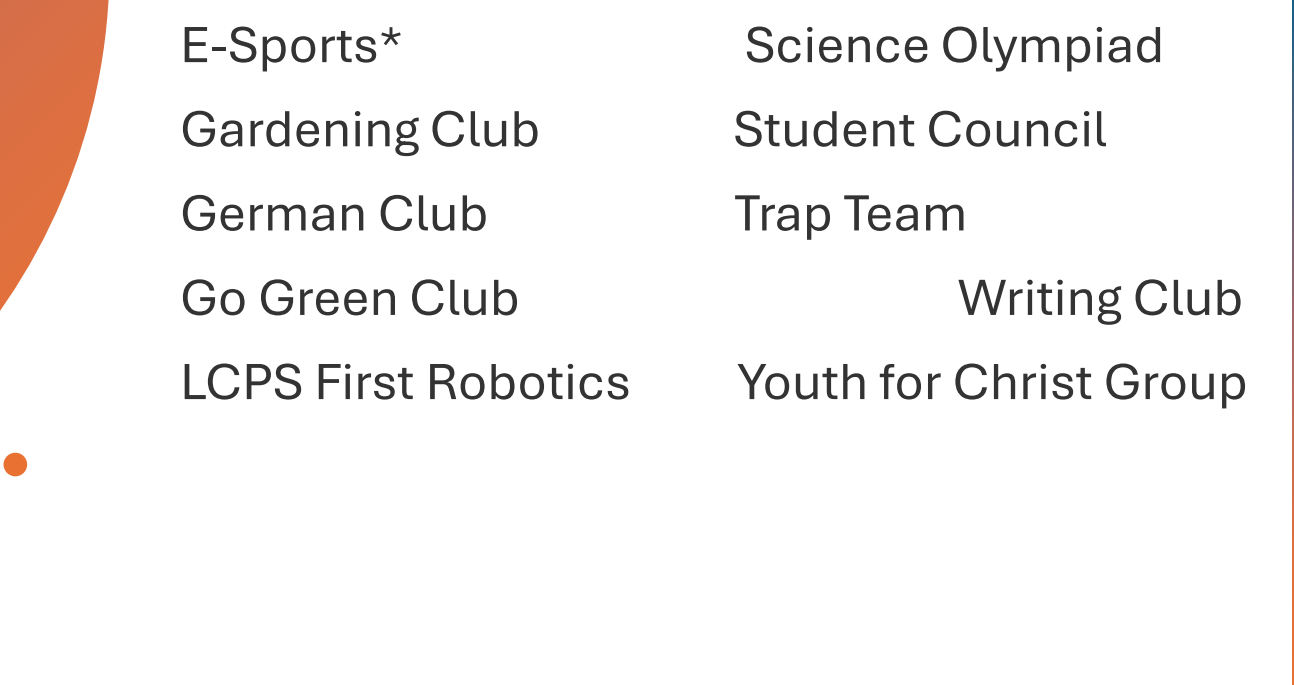

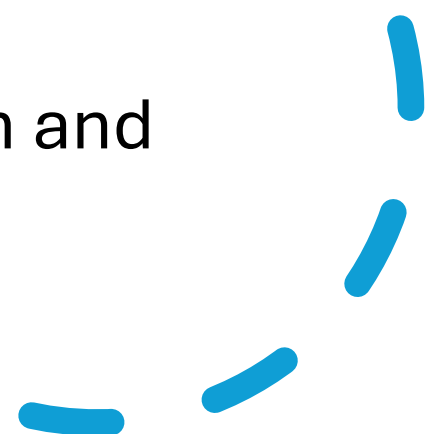
