

Cell Phones and Communication Devices

Electronic communication devices such as cell phones, tablets, smart watches, computers, etc., are devices that are able to communicate with other devices and take/send pictures or video.



The following colors will signify whether the electronic device can be used in a particular location in the building. Teachers have sole discretion in determining the use of electronic devices in their classrooms. Any misuse of electronic devices during class time may result in a referral to an administrator.

Green Area: In a green area, students are able to use electronic communication devices freely and without restriction. The following locations will be designated green areas:

- Cafeteria during lunches
- Commons before/after school and during lunches
- Hallways during passing time

Red Area: In a red area, students are prohibited from using their electronic communication device without express permission from a supervisor of that area. The following areas will be designated red areas:

- Locker rooms
- Bathrooms
- Main Office
- Counseling Office
- Dean's Office

Yellow Area:

Teachers and support staff will determine the time and purpose of electronic communication devices in the classroom. Computers and cell phones may have an academic purpose related to a lesson and may be used with permission.
