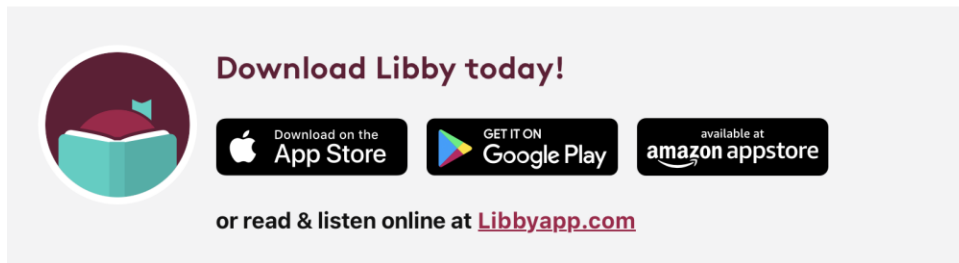

*If you do not have a printer to make copies of the graphic organizer and double entry journal, it is more than okay to complete the work on lined paper.

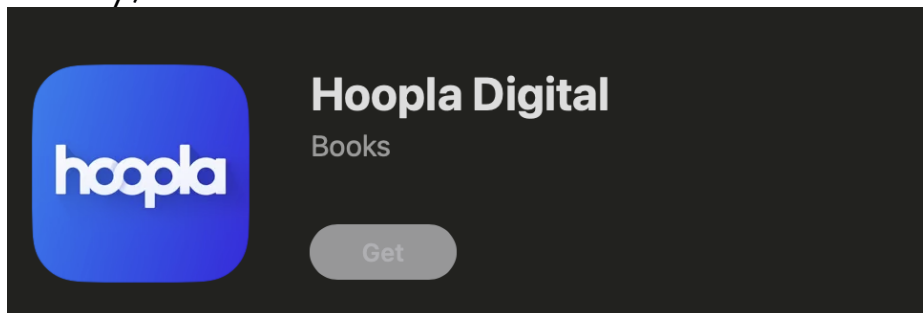
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
