Middle School - East Track Order of Events 2020 Season

Field Events: begin at 3:30. (Long Jump, High Jump, & Shot Put)

Participants competing in Field Events are designated "points" and "exhibition" participants, as determined by practice performance. Points (1^{st} Place= $5/2^{nd}$ Place= $3/3^{rd}$ Place= 1) are awarded to those "points" participants and added to the team's total. "Exhibition" participants try to improve their distance in order to become a "points" participant in the next meet.

Running Events: begin approximately 3:45

In each race, the first heat is the "points" heat. Runners in this heat are competing for points (1st Place= $5/2^{nd}$ Place= $3/3^{rd}$ Place=1) to add to the team's total. The subsequent heats are "exhibition" heats. Participants in these heats are attempting to improve their times and move into the "points" heat in the next meet. Points are not awarded in exhibition heats. Relays: (1st Place= $5/2^{nd}$ Place=0)

In 2020, boys will compete first, followed by the girls in each event. There are 137 possible points awarded in a meet. 69 points are needed in order to win the meet.

Meets end approximately 5:45/6:00, depending on the number of athletes participating.

*7th Graders compete only against 7th Graders and 8th Graders compete only against 8th Graders. All other events - no separation by grade level.
