Sports Physical

All athletes MUST have a current physical on file with the athletic department, in order to participate in any sport. Forms are available on our athletics page.

Grades and Citizenship

Student- athletes need to be in good standing both academically as well as behaviorally. Attached to this packet is a "Student-Athlete Academic and Citizenship Agreement" located on the back of the emergency form. This agreement MUST be signed by both the student-athlete and parent/guardian in order to receive their uniform. For more information, please see the agreement on the BACK of the EMERGENCY FORM.

Attendance

A calendar listing the practices and games for the season is attached. 7th graders will practice from 3:00-4:30pm and 8th graders will practice from 4:30-6:00pm. Please have a ride ready to pick your student/athlete at the appropriate times. We understand that sometimes doctor or dentist appointments come up, if for some reason you are not able to schedule those around our practices, please email or use the remind app to reach a coach if your athlete will be absent from practice.

Behavior

Volleyball athletes must adhere to all school rules and policies at all times during the season. This means that you treat coaches and fellow players in a respectful manner by listening and following directions the first time they are given. Since you are representing our school, athletes are required to uphold a high level of behavior and conduct. Suspension or removal from the team may result if school rules are broken.

<u>Uniforms</u>





Volleyball Uniform Information



- 1. Turn garment inside oot.
- 2. Machine wash cold dark colors seperately 3. Do Not Use Bleach -
- including any color safe bleach. 4. Very Important - do not
- wash with any dacments containing Vetero or abrasive fabrics
- 5. Remové from washer insmediately upon completion of the wash
- 6. Hang dry on plastic hanger.
- 7. Iron on worm or delicate setting only.
- 8. Do Not Dry Clean.

- 3. DO NOT us from on patrines or deceration dye migration and/or color change can occur.


Important Notice

Sublimated garments have graphic designs and performance qualifies that are highly desirable, Unfortunately an inferent property of all polyester garments and sublimated garments in particular is the potential for small picks and pulls. Due to the sublimated dive process these picks may be more visible than on regular dyed parments. This issue is not a melarial defect but reliver a breat issue in all sublimated garments. Extra care should be taken.

L'Anse Creuse Middle School South - Athletic Eligibility Policy

Purpose

Participation in school athletics is a privilege and an important part of a student's educational experience. As representatives of our school, student-athletes are expected to meet academic and behavioral standards that reflect the values of our school community. This policy establishes the expectations for athletic eligibility and outlines the procedures for determining and restoring eligibility.

1. Academic Eligibility

Any student-athlete receiving two (2) or more failing grades (F's) on the weekly athletic eligibility report will be declared ineligible to participate in any scheduled athletic contests for the following week.

- During this period of ineligibility, the student-athlete may continue to attend all team practices and, at the coach's discretion, support their team at athletic events.
- The ineligibility period will begin on the **Monday following the issuance of the weekly eligibility report** and will remain in effect until the next scheduled eligibility review on **Friday**.
- To regain eligibility, the student-athlete must demonstrate significant academic improvement, verified
 either by their teachers or through an updated progress report reflecting passing grades (D- or higher) in
 all courses.

2. Behavioral Eligibility

- Any student-athlete receiving two (2) or more "Needs Improvement" (N) or "Unsatisfactory" (U) marks in
 citizenship or conduct on the weekly athletic eligibility report, or whose behavior warrants disciplinary
 action including suspension (in-school or out-of-school) or repeated detentions, will be deemed ineligible
 to participate in scheduled athletic contests for the following week.
- During this period of ineligibility, the student-athlete may continue to attend team practices and, at the coach's discretion, support their team at athletic events.
- The ineligibility period will begin on the **Monday following the issuance of the weekly eligibility report** and will remain in effect until the next scheduled eligibility review on **Friday**.
- To regain eligibility, the student-athlete must demonstrate consistent improvement in behavior and adherence to school rules, as confirmed by their teachers or school administration.

Acknowledgment & Sign-Off
