Floral Care and Design Skills:

- Prepare floral orders according to customers specific instructions.
- Prepare flowers from warehouse for cooler storage.
- Identify common flowers and foliage used in floral designs.
- Apply design principles for floral and plant arrangements.
- Wire and tape flowers for use in corsages, boutonnieres, and floral arrangements.
- Proficient at pinch and tailored bows, using both satin and wire ribbon of various sizes.
- Make corsage for formal and informal events including attachment of design accessories, ribbon, tulle, and pinch bows.
- Make floral centerpieces using copy design technique.
- Assist other students with care of flowers.

- Maintain tilapia system, including proper nutrition, breeding and growth habits.

Green House and Plant Care:

- Properly care for plants on a daily basis, including determining watering, light, and temperature requirements.
- Prune house plants for proper growth habits and health of plant.
- Feed, care, maintain, and harvest vermin-composting system.
- Completed tissue culture with Venus fly traps.
- Maintain cuttings on misting bench and determine appropriate time when they should be transplanted.
- Transfer flower plugs to four-packs or hanging baskets for sale.
- Prepare soil for outdoor garden.
- Build cold frames for early and late vegetable plantings.
- Design and build small cold frames using available materials.
- Cross-pollinate flowers and maintain records to document progress in a breeding program.
- Prune plants and roots for desired growth patterns.
- Graft plants to take advantage of plants positive features.
- Harvest lettuce, herbs and other vegetables for student operated greenhouse.
